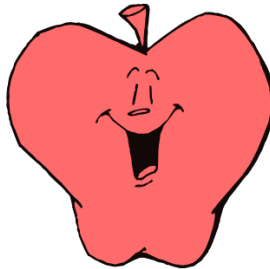


Please "READ" this story to your child. Have them find and count all the targeted letter.

Your child will bring home one letter book every day from A-Z. We learn about one letter each day and use the book to find letters in context. Your child will be familiar with the story, but will probably **NOT** be able to read it. As the note on the front of the book says...

Read and/or sing the book **TO** your child.

With your help, have your child **circle and count** the targeted capital and lowercase letters. *(We always begin circling the letters at school, but may not completely finish.)*

****** I do not have a certain number that is correct/incorrect. I just ask that you do the activity with your child. You can choose to do only the story or include the directions and back page. It is up to you! ******

Write the **total number** for capital and lowercase letters on the cover.

Have your child make a "rainbow letter" on the back page by tracing the capital and lowercase letters with three different colors. *(We did this together today to show you what it looks like.)*

Sign the book and put it back on the **HOMEWORK** side of the folder.
